

Photograph-Pose Story

Materials needed:

- *Digital camera or 36-exposure disposable camera
- *8½ in. x 11 in. white paper
- *8½ in. x 11 in. lined paper
- *Glue
- *Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- *Photo album with magnetic pages

Instructions:

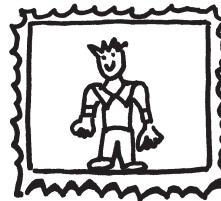
- (1) Take photos of students doing different actions. Example: Bungee jumping, driving a spaceship, etc.
- (2) Teachers should cut around each photo so the only remaining part is the student. The students will use this picture to create a story and illustration of them doing the action shown.
- (3) Students will use the 8½ in. x 11 in. white paper to create a background picture. Example: If they are a bungee jumper, they should draw things up in the sky.

Suggestions for kindergarten teachers:

- *You may need to suggest some actions if students have difficulty thinking of their own.
- *You will also need to cut around the outside of their photos to will prevent them from cutting an arm or leg out of the picture!
